PARKING AND SECURITY

We pay to have the porta potties placed at the beach and cleaned. I was told this week that someone defaced them. This is another reason why we do not want unwanted guests.

Boats are not allowed in the swim areas. Tim Pelton has agreed to help with the permits that will be necessary to put the swim lines back in the water. Unfortunately this will take some time and money. I will keep you updated.

If you see something or someone that is violating the rules please approach them and address the issue. Most people are reasonable.

EAST-WEST LAKE COMMITTEE

Our first presentation on Friday, June 26th, with Jim Ventres, East Haddam Land Use Coordinator, went well in spite of the thunderstorms and the threat of tornados, and we had about 25 hardy souls in attendance. Jim brought many maps of lands up for preservation in the Referendum the following Monday and explained fully the process of trying to save these properties and the justification for doing so. At stake was the Shagru Farm, now known as Lake Hayward Farm, with 273.8 acres; the two Lyons properties, at the end of Devil's Hopyard abutting Salem, and the Valenti property, saved to protect a lovely wooded stream with native trout and salmon. Our fliers were in evidence at the Referendum and we were congratulated for the good turn-out!

The results were as follows (including both machine and absentee ballots): for the Shagru land: 584 yes, 188 no; for the Lyons properties: 572 yes, 200 no; and for the Valenti property: 564 yes, 200 no. Good job, all you participating voters!

At our second presentation on Friday, July 17th, Anita Ballek and Nancy Ballek McKinnon of Ballek's Garden Center spoke on gardening and land use and stewardship at lakeside properties. As Anita was a founding member of the East Haddam Land Trust and both are active in environmental organizations (several associations meet at Anita's house), they are amply qualified to give us good advice.

We are eager to reach people and encourage you to submit your email for inclusion in our growing East-West Lake Hayward Community list. BEACH RULES - (PLEASE INFORM GUESTS AND RENTERS OF THESE RULES)

1. Parents or chaperones are responsible for their child's safety and their child's actions at all times.
2. Children cannot be left at the beach unattended.
3. Infants must be in leak-proof ("swimmie") diapers at all times.
4. Fishing within 100 feet of the swimming area is strictly prohibited.
5. Use of boats and watercraft within the swimming area or within 100 feet of rafts is prohibited.
6. When passing a beach area, dogs must be on a leash. Dogs are never allowed on the beach.
7. There is no swimming after 11pm
8. All trash and cigarette butts must be removed from the beach and be properly disposed of.
9. Use of the beach area is limited to Association members and their guests.


