Waste Management and Recycling at the POALH

Your Board of Governors is in negotiations for a new two-year waste management contract. In the meantime, we have secured an extension of our current waste management contract with All Waste Control, Inc. at the current monthly pricing, for two months, through the end of August with a concession of Monday collection ONLY.

Lake Quality Improvement Committee – Corinne Halliday 6/23/24

Every year representatives from the three lakes in town present a request for funds to the town of East Haddam for the 24/25 budget. I am our representative and am happy to say that we were granted \$15,000 to help offset our yearly expenses dealing with lake quality issues. I also asked for another \$15,000 to help pay for our dam repairs and they also were granted. We have now been awarded a total of \$60,000 towards that repair. Woohoo! (whomever is reading this I just wanted to makeyou say that)

Our yearly treatment for invasive aquatic weeds will continue this year and is scheduled to take place on July 9, 2024. This treatment is being conducted a little later this year so that there is more growth to target. This date is noted on our POALH calendar, was announced in our Spring Packet, and reminders will go out via email blasts and the usual signage placed around the lake. This signage is specific about use of the lake after treatment for specific activities. Swimming is safe to resume the day after according to DEEP and Solitude Lake Management. A pretreatment survey will be conducted on June 27, 2024. As most of you know, Solitude uses a small gas-powered boat for both days so don't be alarmed if you see one. For those of you who are new residents, we go through a very thorough permitting process with the Connecticut Department of Energy & amp; Environmental Protection to obtain a permit to do this spot treatment with herbicides to curtail the growth of invasive aquatic plants. The pretreatment survey determines where we treat. Without a treatment, the lake could be quickly inundated with these plants. As most of you are aware, our lake is susceptible to problems caused by runoff. I will speak about that subject more in next weekend's newsletter and to the board at their next meeting. It is time to get serious about the maintenance of your septic systems and curbing runoff on your own individual properties. These are items that we as an association have the most control over. I highly encourage you to go to the POALH website and read the East Shore Gazette. It's produced by a very involved member of our committee who lives on East Shore Dr. and has a lot of very important information. Lastly, I am looking to step down from my Chair position on this committee by the end of the season. I am happy to stay on the committee to continue my responsibilities as they pertain to the town budgeting process and help facilitate the lake invasive weed treatments. It is not my intention to completely walk away from those responsibilities. I do, however, feel very strongly that your LQIC could benefit from some new energy and interest not only in the Chair position but also more committee members from the association side of the lake. There needs to be a concerted effort towards curbing runoff into the lake and I'm hoping that a new Chair will bring the energy needed to address that. You will have a good team behind you, I promise. Please feel free to email me with any questions you may have.
